- Low-cost improvements: Low cost Loft insulation, some draught proofing, old cellar insulation, to be renewed and improved with recycled plastic insulation
- **Glazing**: double glazed conservatory, some refurbished sash windows.
- F Renewable electricity: solar PV
- **Renewable Heat**: Solar water heating to supplement efficient Vaillant condensing boiler
- Sustainable building materials e.g. reclaimed or recycled features; natural materials like hemp or woodchip
- **Lifestyle changes**: garden with vegetable beds, no car.
