## More information about this home

South Yorkshire Energy Centre is a retrofitted Victorian house that opens all year round as a visitor centre. An end-terrace with no neighbours left, up to 2006 it would have been one of Sheffield's least energy-efficient homes! The work done to insulate the building and install renewable energy sources has made it a model of how to create a warm and low-cost home. On show are solar electricity and solar water heating, a ground source heat pump, different types of internal solid wall insulation, electricity monitoring and a solar light tube. There are also fun activities for all the family, including two energy-generating bikes!

## Low carbon measures on show

- 'Big' insulation works: Full internal wall insulation and displays of different materials
- Glazing: Double glazing and high spec doors
- Lighting systems and electrical appliances: Sun pipe and low energy lighting (not LED)
- \*C High spec heating: Underfloor heating in solid floor with demo cut-away
- Renewable heat: Ground source heat pump and information display; solar water heating using evacuated tubes, solar kiln for timber drying
- **Renewable electricity**: solar electricity with monitoring and displays; plus there is a medium size wind turbine on the associated Heeley City Farm site
- Sustainable building materials: Sustainable materials used include reclaimed timber used for kitchen and other furniture
- Lifestyle changes: Cycle racks available for staff and visitors to use.
